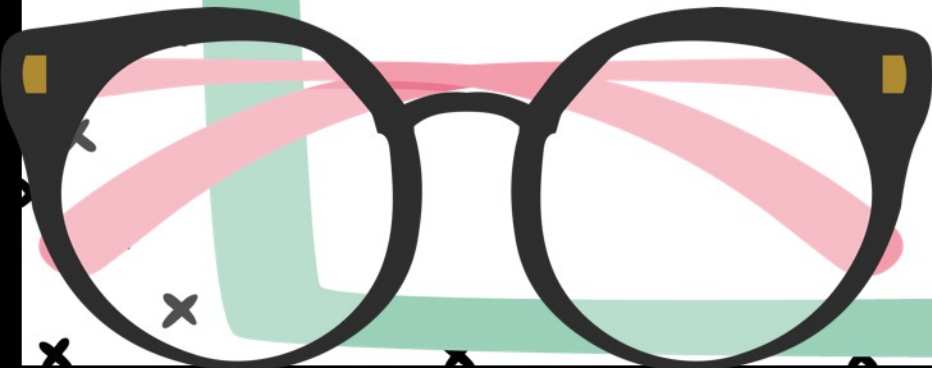

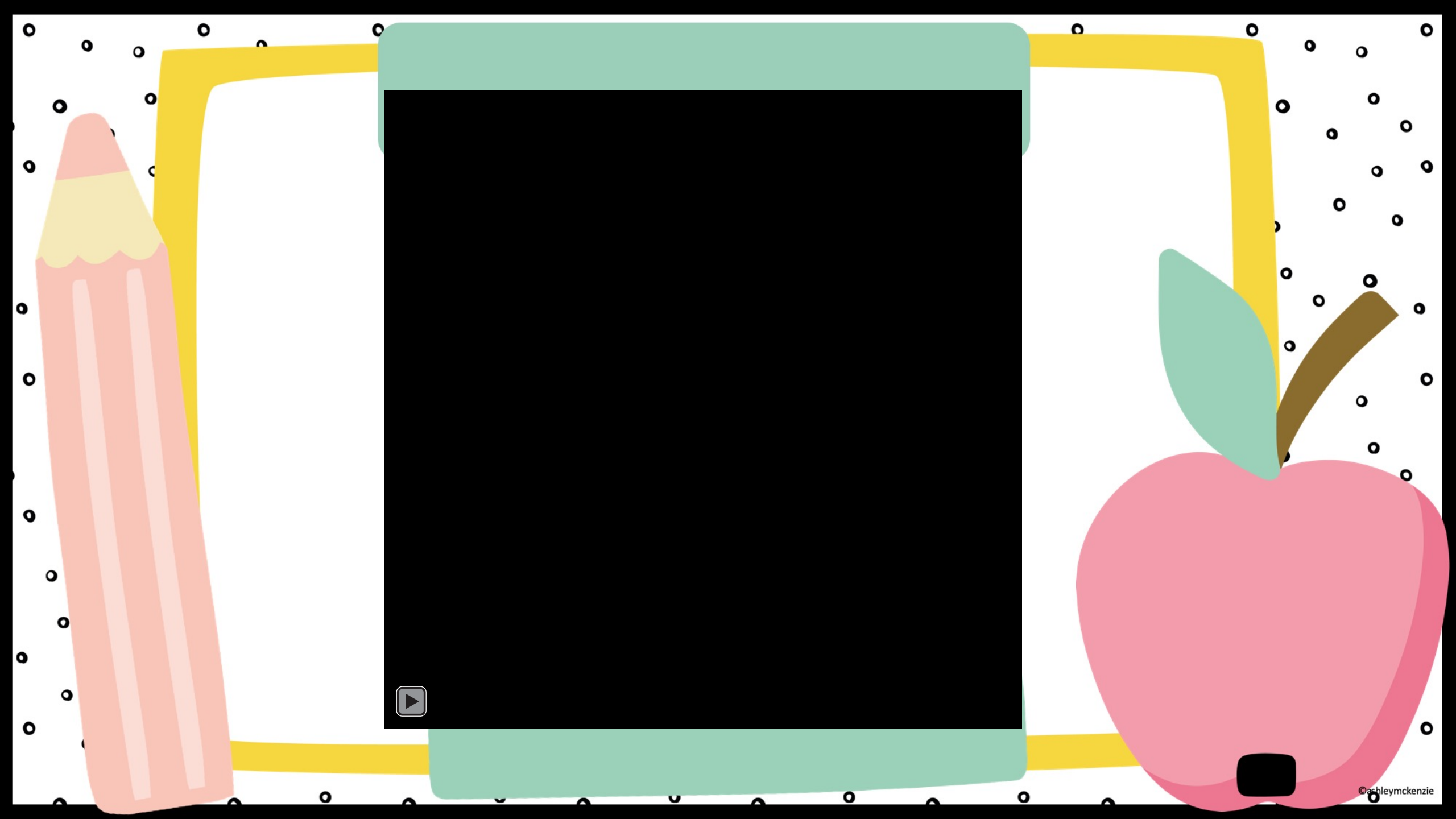


Hello! My name is Mrs. Beutler

Consequences for not following classroom rules:

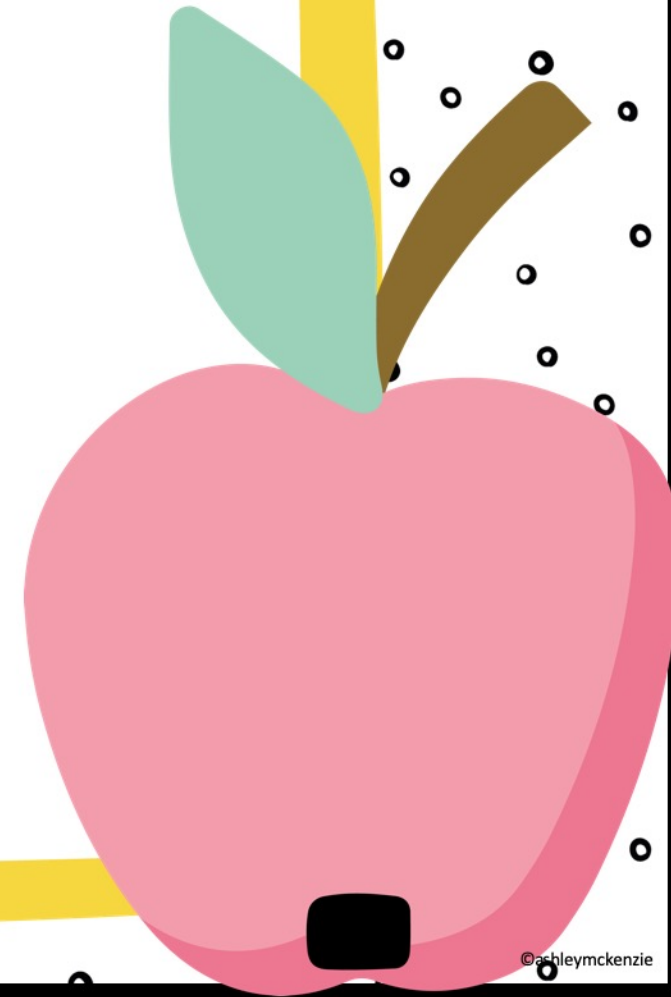
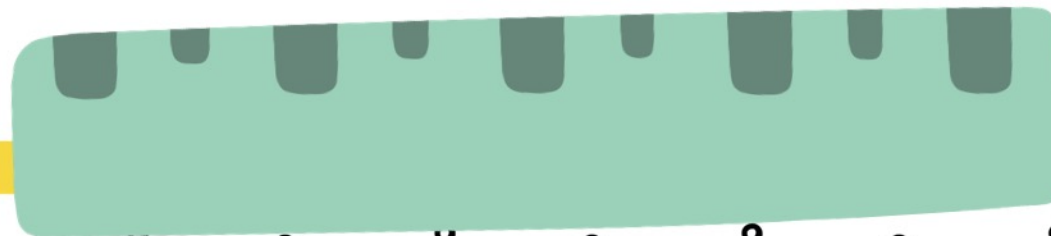
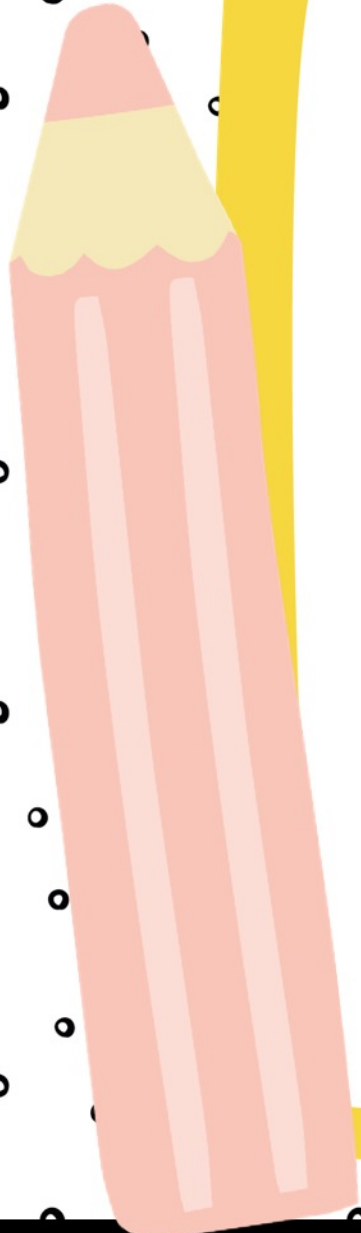
1. Warning and reminder of the rules
2. Students are asked to refocus and reflect on their choices
3. If behavior continues students will miss one minute of an activity to discuss their choices and reflect how to improve behavior.
4. If disruptive behaviors continue daily, parents will be notified.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is a major key in your child's education.

Please have your child to school on time to receive all the benefits of learning.

At home learning days will consist of 30-40 minutes per core subject. We will be sending home a weekly checklist of expectations for remote learning days.

Please do not send party invitations to be passed out at school. (Unless the whole class is invited) Thank you!

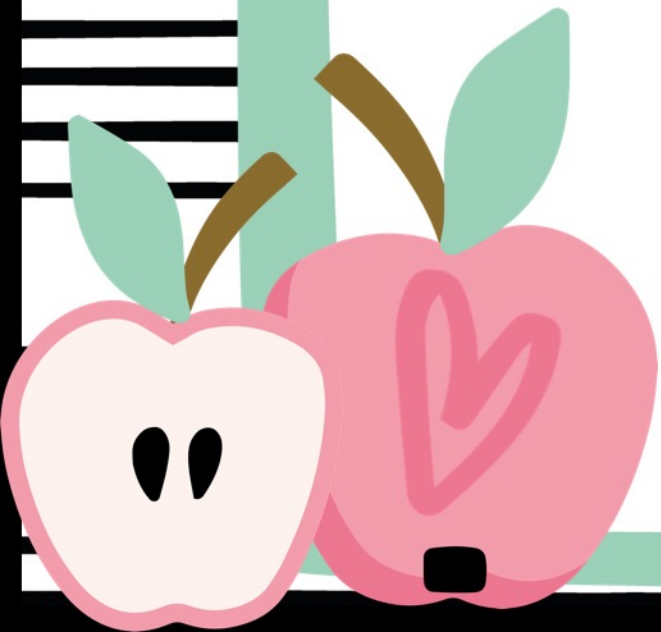
LUNCH

bottle to keep at their desk.

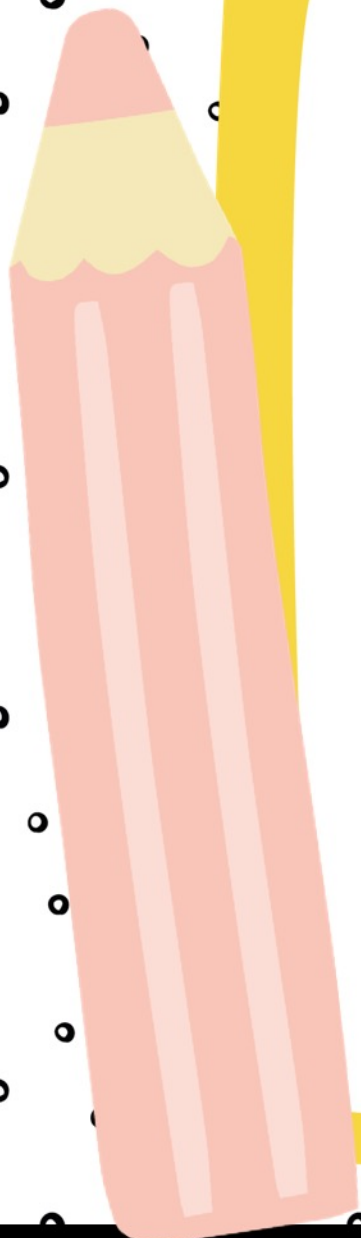

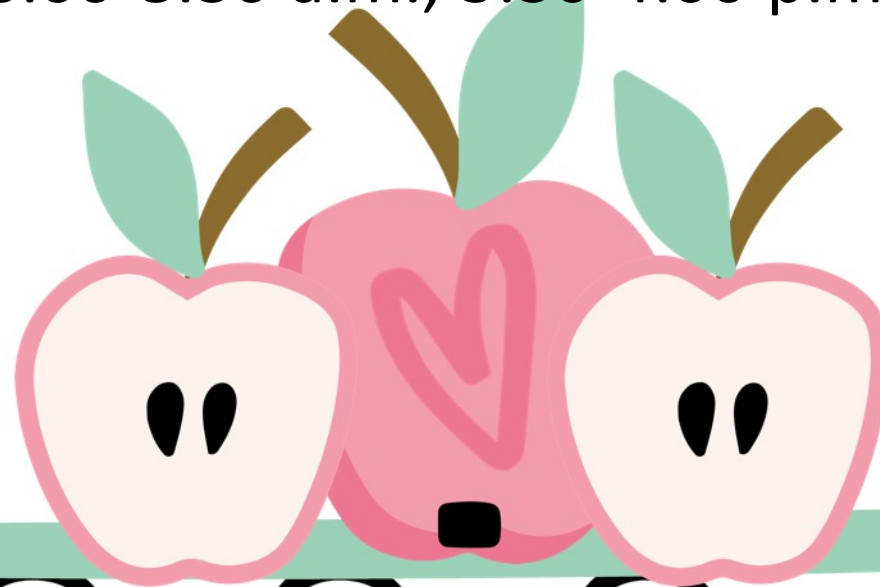
